#### Hi folks.

I believe Ozola has sent out an email or two regarding the administrative record and emails, with a suggested sorting of categories, based on an earlier EQD request. I'd like to simplify this process if possible. If you have *sent* emails that are relevant to the dog plan in some way, please print that email (and any attachment you sent with it) and save it electronically as well. You do NOT need to sort these documents. If you think it is confidential or FOIA exempt for some reason (most common reason is that it is an internal deliberative document - i.e. it shows internal agency decisionmaking), just put a post-it on the document to that effect. Eventually, somone on the dog mgmt. plan team will gather all of these documents, probably on an ongoing basis. We (someone on the dog mgmt. plan team) will then send them to our contractor who will sort and input them into our overall administrative record database.

Aside from emails, some folks have probably generated other documents that are relevant to the dog plan. This is most likely limited to the core dog planning team. These documents should also be retained for the admin record.

To reiterate, we only ask that you keep, and eventually print, those emails and attachments <u>you sent</u> that are <u>relevant</u> to the dog plan, and other documents <u>you have generated</u> that are relevant to the dog plan. Relevant does not mean discussing the spa treatment you'll need after the dog plan is complete!!! It generally means emails and documents that are in any of the following categories:

Legal, policy & guidance: includes all laws, regulations, policy documents or other applicable guidance used in developing the plan, whether NPS or other

Internal corresp. & mtgs: emails between NPS, conference call notes, any material exchanged

between NPS (contractors) in developing the plan

Public comments, mtgs, notes: public comments, mtg notes from public, public meeting materials, anything disseminated to the public or received from the public, NOIs, NOAs

Newspaper/ mag & press release: any non- technical article published on-line, newspaper, magazine, flyer, etc.

Technical & scientific rpts/ data scientific or technical reports or journal articles, or data used in developing the plan

Draft & final compliance docs draft chapters & documents, final compliance documents, compliance documents relied on in the course of developing the plan (BO, EA, EISs, etc)

Agency / consultation mtgs, corresp.: correspondence and meeting materials and notes with other agencies/ Tribes
